OUR SERVICES

Recovery Program

The Recovery Program commences with a face to face assessment, allowing a recovery plan to be written. This encompasses all aspects of a persons life, including their dreams and goals for the future.

Family and Carer Program

In the mental health sector carers are people who are often forgotten. Providing support and advice in times of stress, this service covers many areas of the South West. We explore the carers own needs and address the pressures carers often experience. They can meet with other carers in support groups helping them discover that they are not alone. Carers also learn about mental illness in order to better care for their loved ones and themselves.

Supported Housing Program

Pathways SouthWest is a community housing provider and maintains a number of houses dedicated to people living with mental health challenges. Pathways SouthWest is a benevolent landlord for our tenants, reducing many of the tensions created by difficulties in finding accommodation and maintaining properties in good order.

Pathways SouthWest Clubhouse

We believe that the peaceful surrounds of our Clubhouse at Turkey Point provides a unique opportunity for provision of a restorative mental health service and social connection with a number of activities available.

Psychoeducational Programs

We have a range of psychoeducational programs available for both carers and people living with mental health challenges.
